The Adventist Ball League (ABL) is a co-ed Christian softball organization sponsored by the Children's Ministries Division of the La Sierra University Church (LSUC).

ABL is open to boys and girls from ages 5-13: four (4) teams in the Cadet Division: ages 5-7; six (6) teams in the Minor Division: ages 8-10; and six (6) teams in the Major Division: ages 11-13. Players MUST be within age group for that specific division. Those who are turning an age to qualify for the next division may move up into the new division if their birthday is between opening day and the end of season. Those turning 14 before opening day are not eligible to play. Rosters will be filled on a first come first served basis and will be based on completion of registration form, fees, and insurance information.

Teams are guided by an Executive Board, Pastoral Supervisor, Managers, and Coaches. The youth are expected to practice Christian courtesy and learn teamwork, sportsmanship, and softball skills. Teams are outfitted in complete league uniforms.

The season will run from February through May with regulation games played on Sundays on the La Sierra Academy fields.

Parents and older brothers or sisters are encouraged to attend the games and become involved as coaches, umpires, or team family helpers.

UNIFORMS: All players must wear the complete issue uniforms at each game. All player fees cover a purchased uniform and it is the responsibility of the player to keep the complete uniform in good condition during the season.

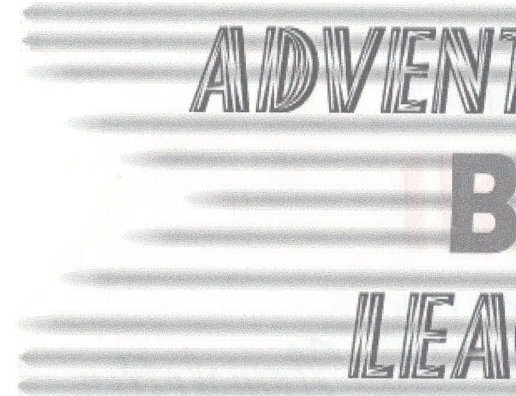
